
2023 Hike for Hope Results

espite drizzly weather, nearly 850 supporters of Hope Hospice gathered at Del Valle Regional Park on May 6 for our annual Hike for Hope. An impressive 1,174 registrants committed to the fundraiser and helped raise \$153,000, but late-spring inclement weather deterred some families from attending the hike itself.

Unprecedented winter storms kept Del Valle Regional Park closed to the public for several preceding months. It was looking like we'd have to relocate or reschedule our event.
